OFFER DESCRIPTION

By order 22/04/2022, the Rector of the University of Évora, it is open, for a period of 30 working days, from the date of publication of this notice in the Diário da República, without prejudice to the disclosure on the Public Employment Scholarship, 'on the websites of the Foundation for Science and Technology, I. P., and on the website of the University of Évora (IJÉ), in Portuguese and English, an international documentary competition for the recruitment of an assistant researcher for the exercise of activities in the scientific area of Earth Sciences at the Institute of Earth Sciences (ICT) – Évora Pole.

This competition is covered by the provisions of the doctoral contracting regime aimed at stimulating scientific and technological employment in all areas of knowledge (RJEC), approved by Decree-Law No. 57/2016 of August 29, in the wording given by Law No. 57/2017 of July 19, inserting itself in the Program for Stimulating Scientific Employment funded by FCT, after approval in the Incentive competition for Institution Scientific Employment.

In compliance with Article 9(h).⁰ of the Constitution, the Public Administration, as an employer, actively promotes a policy of equal opportunity between men and women in access to employment and professional progression, providing scrupulously in order to avoid any form of discrimination.

The applicant may be in charge of teaching service, up to a maximum of 4 hours per week, in the curricular units distributed to him,

In accordance with the RJEC and other legislation in force, the following provisions shall be observed:

1 - General and special admission requirements:

1.1- General requirements: those defined in Article 17 of the General Law of Work in Public Functions (LTFP), approved by Lei No. 35/2014, of June 20.

1.2 - Special requirements: those defined in Article 10 of the Scientific Research Career Statute (ECIC), i.e., individuals who hold a PhD degree in the scientific fields of Earth and Environmental Sciences or similar, and those who, although Doctors in other areas, have a relevant scientific curriculum in the area of the competition; post-doctoral experience or scientific curriculum after doctorate, including scientific articles published after obtaining a PhD or mentoring post-graduate students. Scientific curricula that reveal experience in the following aspects will be valued:

(a) remote sensing applied to atmosphere, solid Earth, inland waters, terrestrial ecosystems or archaeology; or monitoring of aquatic ecosystems; or structural geology; or modeling of solar receptors;

b) Fieldwork in Earth sciences (including geophysics, meteorology, geology, limnology or radiometry), in the areas of observation, use and maintenance of instrumentation.

c) Guidance of PhD, master and or internship students;

d) Participation in the preparation and realization of research projects;

(e) participation in service and other activities to support society

1.3 - Holders of a doctoral degree obtained abroad must have equivalence/recognition/registration of that degree to an identical degree awarded by the Portuguese university. Opponents of the competition covered by the provisions of paragraph 1.2 who do not meet this requirement will be conditionally admitted, with conditional admission being maintained until the date of the hiring act. The candidates who do not demonstrate the approval of their equivalence/recognition/registration requests by this date will be excluded.

2 - Workplace: Institute of Earth Sciences (ICT) - Évora Pole, University of Évora, Évora

3 - The net monthly remuneration corresponds to index 195, rank 1, of the category of assistant researcher, as described in Annex I to the ECIC.

4 - Formalization of applications: Applications are submitted through an application addressed to the Rector of the University of Évora, under the following terms and conditions:

4.1 The application must contain, among others, the following elements:

- a) Identification of the Contest;
- b) Identification of the applicant by full name, date and place of birth, nationality, civil identification number and expiration date, profession, marital status, residence and postal address, email address and telephone number;
- (c) Indication of the category and institution where the service is provided, when applicable;
- (d) indication of the degrees held by the applicant;
- (e) indication of the ratings obtained in performance evaluation processes, when applicable
- (f) mention that the applicant declares that the elements or facts contained in the application are true.

4.2 The application is accompanied by the following documentation:

- (a) Certificate(s) attesting ownership and date of award of degree and qualifications required for the competition;
- b) Certificate/declaration of service time issued by the service if there is a link to the civil service;
- (c) Curriculum vitae of the candidate with an indication of his scientific work, including: research activities, experience and professional training, service to the community and technology transfer, scientific guidance and management that are considered relevant for the competition, namely, in the areas indicated in number 1.2 of this public notice and identifying the activities carried out in the different aspects that, under the terms of article 5.0 of the ECIC, are part of the set of functions to be performed by an assistant researcher. The curriculum vitae must indicate up to five works that the candidate considers most representative in the area in which the competition is open and, on them, present a succinct justification description of their contribution.;
- d) a digital copy (pdf) of the scientific articles published in international journals mentioned in the curriculum vitae and other works that the candidates consider relevant for the jury's assessment;
- e) A digital media copy (PDF) of a scientific project that the candidate proposes to carry out at ICT (maximum of 5000 words);
- (f) other diplomas or certificates of the courses referred to in the curriculum vitae;
- g) Attest proof of physical robustness and psychic profile, indispensable to the exercise of functions;
- (h) updated mandatory vaccination bulletin.

4.3 Documents in accordance with points (g) and (h) of the preceding paragraph may be replaced by a declaration made in the application, under commitment of honour, where, in separate points, the applicant shall define his/her precise situation relating to the content of

each of those points.

4.4 In the application itself or in a separate document, applicants must declare, under commitment of honour, what the precise situation they are in relation to the content of each of the following lines:

a) Nationality;

(b) is not inhibited from the performance of public functions or prohibited for the performance of the duties to which he/she applies,

4.5 - Failure to comply with the deadline for submission of the application fixed, as well as the failure to submit or submit the documents referred to in paragraphs (a) to (e) of paragraph 4.2 of this notice, determine the exclusion of the application.

4.6 - Applicants submit their applications and supporting documents, preferably in digital media (pdf format), via email to drhsc@uevora.pt address, in person at the University of Évora - Human Resources Division (DRH), Administrative Services, Largo da Sr.^a da Naatividade, Apartado 94, 700 2-554 Évora, Portugal, during office hours, or by post to the same address. When sent by post, the post must be registered, with acknowledgment of receipt, dispatched until the last day of the opening period of the call for tenders, which is fixed 30 working days after publication of this Notice.

4.7 By determination of the Jury, the candidate may be asked for additional documentation on the curriculum presented, as well as public hearings of the admitted candidates.

4.8 The false statements made by the candidates shall be punished in accordance with the law.

6- Evaluation methods and criteria:

6.1 The following are evaluation criteria:

- (a) scientific performance, taking into account the strands indicated in paragraph 1.2;
- b) The research programme to be carried out in ICT - Évora in the next 6 years, proposed by the candidate;
- c) Public presentation of the admitted candidates, by determination of the jury.

6.2 In the application of the above mentioned criteria, the following parameters and weighting factors are evaluated:

Criterion a) with a weighting factor of 75%, which includes:

- a1) publications in journals and book chapters, considering the quality of publications, being evaluated the quality of the scientific content of the most relevant works selected by the candidates - 40%;
- a2) research experience, considering the participation and leadership in research projects and the provision of services to the community - 10%;
- a3) experience of guidance and participation in academic evidence juries - 10%
- a4) knowledge and technology transfer experience - 10%;
- a5) experience in the organization of scientific events and scientific dissemination - 5%

Criterion b) with a weighting factor of 25%, which includes:

- b1) quality, feasibility and scientific relevance of the proposal - 10%;
- b2) framework of the proposal in the areas defined in paragraph 1.2 a) - 10%.
- b3) adequacy of the candidate's work proposal curriculum - 5%

Criterion c) Public presentation of the project with weighting factor that can go up to 10% of the overall weighting, if the jury considers it pertinent to hear the best classified candidates in criteria a) and b).

7. The final classification system for candidates is expressed on a scale from 0 to 100.

8. The jury shall act by means of a reasoned roll-call vote in accordance with the selection criteria adopted and disclosed, and abstentions are not allowed.

9. Minutes shall be drawn up from the meetings of the jury, which contain a summary of what has occurred therein, as well as the votes cast by each of the members and their reasons, and shall be provided to the candidates whenever requested.

10. After completing the application of the selection criteria, the jury shall draw up the orderly list of successful candidates with their classification.

11. The final decision of the jury shall be approved by the highest-level officer of the institution to which it is also incumbent to decide on the contract.

12. The list of candidates admitted and excluded as well as the final classification list are advertised on the <http://www.sadm.uevora.pt> website, and candidates are notified by e-mail with an entrega receipt of the notification.

13. Prior hearing and deadline for the final decision: Pursuant to Article 121 of the Code of Administrative Procedure, after notified, candidates have 10 working days to comment. Within 90 days, from the limit for the submission of applications, the final decisions of the jury shall be given.

14. This competition is intended exclusively for the filling of the vacancy indicated, and may be terminated until the approval of the final ordination list of the candidates and lapsed with the respective occupation of the job on offer.

15. Policy of non-discrimination and equal access: The University of Évora actively promotes a policy of non-discrimination and equal access, so that no candidate may be privileged, benefited, impaired or deprived of any right or exempt from any duty on the grounds, inter alia, of ancestry, age, sex, sexual orientation, marital status, family situation, economic situation, education, origin or social condition, genetic heritage, reduced working capacity, disability, chronic disease, nationality, ethnic origin or race, territory of origin, language, religion, political or ideological convictions and trade union membership.

16. Pursuant to Decree-Law No. 29/2001 of February 3, the candidate with disabilities has preference in equal classification, which prevails over any other legal preference. Applicants must declare on the application form, under compromisso of honour, their degree of disability, the type of disability and the means of communication/expression to be used in the selection process, in accordance with the above-mentioned diploma.
